Processing Error / Testing Considerations: To account for processing error and pH testing considerations during preparation, it is suggested to measure an additional **12 to 15%** of the required quantities of ingredients.

Clindamycin Phosphate has a Narrow Therapeutic Index.

This procedure requires the use of very small quantities of ingredients. All calculations and preparation techniques must be verified before dispensing the final product.

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5.	<p><u>Powder-liquid preparation:</u></p> <p>A. Combine and triturate the following ingredients together to form a fine homogeneous powder blend:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-Hydrous Benzoyl Peroxide (amount determined in Step 1Aii)-Clindamycin Phosphate (amount determined in Step 3Aii) <p>B. Levigate the fine, homogeneous powder blend (Step 5A) with the Ethoxy Diglycol.</p> <p><u>End result:</u> Homogeneous paste-like dispersion.</p> <p><u>IMPORTANT NOTE:</u> It is very important to have a smooth dispersion at this stage!!</p>																										



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6.	<p><u>Powder-liquid to medium integration:</u></p> <p>A. Incrementally add the homogeneous paste-like dispersion (Step 5B) to the VersaPro™ Gel Base (amount determined in Step 4Aii).</p> <p><u>Specifications:</u> Continuously mix, using high-shear mixing techniques.</p> <p><u>End result:</u> Homogeneous gel-like dispersion.</p>
7.	<p><u>Viscosity adjustment</u></p> <p>A. If the final result is too liquid or not thick enough, incrementally add the LiquiGel Complex™, about 0.5 mL at a time, to the homogeneous gel-like dispersion (Step 6A) and thoroughly mix for 2 minutes. Repeat the procedure until the desired viscosity is attained.</p> <p><u>Note:</u> The amount of LiquiGel Complex™ could be within the range of 1% to 6%.</p> <p>B. If the final result is gritty, pass it through the ointment mill until it becomes smooth and uniform.</p>
8.	<p><u>pH testing:</u></p> <p>A. Draw an appropriate amount of the mixture (Step 7B).</p> <p>B. Test the pH of the sample. It should lie between 4.5 and 6.5.</p> <p>C. <u>If the pH < 4.5, carefully add, in a dropwise fashion, the Sodium Hydroxide 10% Solution to the mixture:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Draw and transfer 1 or 2 drops of the Sodium Hydroxide 10% Solution to the mixture.2. Stir for at least 5 minutes to evenly disperse the Sodium Hydroxide 10% Solution.3. Re-test the pH.4. Continue to add the Sodium Hydroxide 10% Solution until the pH of 4.5 to 6.5 is obtained. <p>IMPORTANT: Do not allow the pH to rise above 6.5.</p> <p>D. <u>If the pH > 6.5, carefully add, in a dropwise fashion, the Hydrochloric Acid 10% Solution to the mixture:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Draw and transfer 1 or 2 drops of the Hydrochloric Acid 10% Solution to the mixture.2. Stir for at least 5 minutes to evenly disperse the Hydrochloric Acid 10% Solution.3. Re-test the pH.4. Continue to add the Hydrochloric Acid 10% Solution until the pH of 4.5 to 6.5 is obtained. <p>IMPORTANT: Do not allow the pH to fall below 4.5.</p>
9.	<p><u>Product transfer:</u></p> <p>Transfer the final product into the specified dispensing container (see “Packaging requirements”).</p>
